Central Government: Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education (MoE)	Overall responsible for framing education policy, formulating programme guidelines and disbursement of funds on sharing basis to States & UTs with regard to Centrally Sponsored Schemes, such as Samagra Shiksha & other such programme launched from time to time.	
State Government: State Implementation Society (SIS) & State Government Education Department	Overall responsible for implementation of Centrally Sponsored Schemes and for policy formulation at the state level concerning issues falling its jurisdiction, academic & administrative planning, management & monitoring. State Implementation Society receive money released by the State Government matching with the Grants received from the Central Government.	Number of States: 28 Number of Units: 8
District Education Office	Planning, administration and management units, overall responsible to formulate district school education plans based on the inputs its received from the lower level i.e. Block level.	Number of Districts: 741 (2011 Census)
Block Resource Centre & Block Education Office	Capacity building & academic support to teachers & monitoring & overall supervision of programmes under implementation in the block	Number of Blocks: 7,457 (U-DISE 2017)
Cluster Resource Centre	Academic support to school teachers onsite falling under its jurisdiction. On an average a Cluster Resource Centre has 10 to 25 schools under its jurisdiction	Number of Clusters 82,952 located in 5,94,130 villages (U-DISE 2017)
School	It is the location where overall planning as envisaged at the upper levels is supposed to be implemented	Number of Schools: 15,51,000 (UDISE+ 2018)
